




Disaster Declarations for Berkeley, Dorchester, Charleston County (1953-2024)




Historical Air Quality in South Carolina, by County (2019)






Annual Average Max Heat Index (1979 – 2021) for August, by County



Outdoor Occupations in South Carolina Number of workers




Heat days in Berkeley, Dorchester, Charleston County Projected no. of days in a year with 'feels like' temperature at or





Percentage of Weeks SC was in Drought (2021), by County


